22 TO DEBTORS, THE UNITED STATES TRUSTEE, AND OTHER INTERESTED PARTIES:

23 PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that a hearing on the Motion to Abstain and for Relief from  
24 Automatic Stay to Permit Lawsuit to Proceed to Trial and Conclusion (“the Motion”) filed by  
25 MICHAEL MARROQUIN (“Plaintiff”) will be heard by the Honorable Dennis Montali on  
26 December 11, 2019 at 10:00 a.m. in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Northern  
27 District of California located at 450 Golden Gate Avenue, 16<sup>th</sup> Floor, San Francisco, California

1 in Courtroom 17. Plaintiff is requesting through the Motion that the Bankruptcy Court (a)  
2 abstain from adjudicating Plaintiff's claim against Pacific Gas & Electric Company ("Debtor")  
3 and other defendants named in Kern County Superior Court Case No. BCV-18-100020 ("the  
4 Lawsuit") and (b) modify the automatic stay so that the Lawsuit can be tried and concluded  
5 without any restrictions caused by Debtor filing for relief under the Bankruptcy Code.  
6 Plaintiff's claim against Debtor and the other defendants named in the Lawsuit are for personal  
7 injuries that arise from an incident that occurred in Kern County, California on or about May 25,  
8 2017. Plaintiff's claim is based on claims for Property Damage and Personal Injury caused by  
9 the operation of a Motor Vehicle and General Negligence.

10 The Motion is brought per 28 USC Section 1334(c)(1) and 11 USC Section 362(d)(1) for  
11 cause. The Motion is based on this Notice, the Motion, the Declarations of Daniel Rodriguez  
12 and Leonard K. Welsh filed in support of the Motion and upon all other pleadings and papers on  
13 file herein and such oral and documentary evidence as may be presented at the hearing on the  
14 Motion.

15 PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that the Debtor is advised to appear personally or  
16 by counsel at the preliminary hearing as provided in Bankruptcy Local Rule for the Northern  
17 District of California 4001-1(a) and that failure to so appear may result in the Court granting the  
18 relief requested without further hearing, including the lifting of the automatic stay to allow  
19 Plaintiff to pursue completion of litigation, pretrial proceedings, trial, post-trial motions and any  
20 appellate proceedings in or in connection with the Lawsuit. Respondent(s) may but will not be  
21 required to file responsive pleadings, points and authorities, and declarations in response to the  
22 Motion as provided in Bankruptcy Local Rule 4001-1(f)


23 PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that any opposition or response to the Motion
