

FAQ for Owners of Recalled Vehicles

1. Will the Chapter 11 filing affect my ability to get a recalled inflator replaced?

No. The Chapter 11 filing in the U.S. and proposed sale to KSS should have no effect on the ability of drivers to get replacements for recalled Takata airbag inflators free of charge. Vehicle owners should respond to the recall notice that they received or vehicle owners in the U.S. can visit <https://www.airbagrecall.com/> for more information on airbag inflator replacements.

2. Where can I replace my airbag?

Vehicle owners in the U.S. should continue to visit <https://www.airbagrecall.com/> for more information on airbag inflator replacements and to determine if your vehicle is impacted by the recall. If it is impacted, you should contact your local dealer, which will be equipped to fix the recalled part or portion of your vehicle.
